ENGLISH – PERSUASIVE

Students will write and share their opinion on a topic using topic-specific vocabulary and a persuasive structure. Students need to write simple sentences using capital letters and full stops correctly.

Year 2 students need to write compound sentences with capital letters, full stops and commas.

MATHS

Number

Students will use addition, subtraction, sharing and grouping strategies to solve everyday mathematical problems and explain their thinking. Year 2 students will use mathematical modelling to solve multiplicative problems.

Space/Measurement

Identifies, compares and sorts shapes and objects by their features, such as sides, corners, faces and edges.

Accurately measures and compares the length of objects using informal units
Year 2 – Uses repeated halving to show halves, quarters and eighths fractions.

HEALTH & RESPECT

Students will recognise how strengths and achievements contribute to identities. They will identify how emotional responses impact on others' feelings. Students will recognise their body's warning signs, learn how to stay safe and practise strategies to seek safety and get help.

DIGITAL TECH

Students use digital technologies confidently to complete tasks and solve simple problems. They create and share information using software, recognise patterns in data, and follow steps to achieve a goal. Students demonstrate safe and responsible behaviour when working and sharing online.
