Term 2 Year 3 / 4

ENGLISH

This term, students will explore how informative texts are structured and how visual features enhance meaning. They will plan, write and create their own multimodal information report about the Great Barrier Reef, and present their final report to an audience.

MATHEMATICS

Students will be learning various mathematic concepts, including number and time. Students will complete two assessments throughout the term.

LITERACY

Students are focusing on fluency, including accuracy, automaticity and prosody. Monitoring fluency helps support comprehension, allowing students to read smoothly and with expression.

HEALTH

Students will explore how emotions can change in different situations and learn how to interact positively with others. They will also develop decision-making and problem-solving skills to choose strategies that help keep them safe.

RESPECTFUL RELATIONS

Students will learn how human rights help us value ourselves and others, show respect, and appreciate diversity. They will also practise standing up for their own rights and the rights of others.
