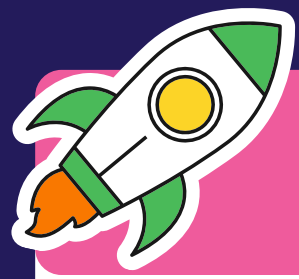

Mathematics

In Mathematics, students will explore a range of concepts including:

Number: build confidence with numbers by using efficient strategies for multiplication and division, exploring factors and multiples, and applying their skills to solve real-life problems while checking that their answers make sense.

Measurement: learn to work with time by converting between units, understanding 12- and 24-hour formats, and using timetables to solve everyday problems.

Languages



In Darumbal Language students will explore the concept of belonging to family, school and Country while building an understanding of connections to family (mob), land (nunthi), flags. Together we will learn about totems and how they represent identity, strengths and connection to the land. During Reconciliation Week students will learn of shared history and the importance of connection to family and land.



Health

They are exploring the concepts of health and wellbeing and the importance of healthy habits as a preventative measure. They identify good habits and how they contribute to overall health and wellbeing.



English



Students will engage with a range of texts related to natural disasters and develop an understanding of the purpose of an information report, focusing on the clear and effective communication of factual information. They will conduct research to gather relevant information and present their findings through a multimodal information report.
