English

This term, students will be learning how to read, view and comprehend a variety of poems.

They will explore the characteristic features of poetry, such as stanzas, rhyme, rhythm, repetition, imagery and figurative language (like similes and metaphors).

Maths

Students are building their number skills by working with decimals, factors, multiples, fractions, and percentages to solve problems and explain their thinking. They are also exploring chance and probability by predicting, testing, and comparing how likely different events are to happen.

Health

In Health, students will recognise the influence of emotions and discuss factors that influence how people interact in new situations. Students will investigate developmental changes and transitions.





Design Technology

In Design and Technologies, students will design a service that provides an edible plant used to make a healthy food product. Students will also create packaging and a fact sheet about their plant. During the project, they'll explore the design process by investigating, creating, and evaluating their ideas.

Reading



In Reading, students will continue to strengthen their fluency, accuracy, and expression while engaging in a variety of texts. They will be given opportunities to read aloud and participate in discussions, helping to build both confidence and comprehension skills.
