
3/4 TERM2 NEWSLETTER

English

This term, students will create and present a spoken procedure in the role of a character from a story, where the character is explaining how to do something.

We will be reading the novel: George's Marvellous Medicine and analysing the characters. Students can then choose a character to become for their presentation to create their very own marvellous medicine!





Science

Welcome back to term 2. This term year 34 students will be learning about Earth and Space Sciences. In the unit, Spinning Earth, students will use their understanding of the movement of Earth to suggest explanations for everyday observations such as day and night, sunrise and sunset and shadows. They will identify the observable and nonobservable features of Earth and compare its size with the sun and moon. They will make observations of the changes in sunlight during the day and investigate how Earth's movement causes these changes.
